Greetings from Ontario, Canada. This article for the January 2011 TRAP & FIELD was submitted before the end of November, so I cannot yet announce the members of the Delegate team and category Delegate team until I have received all the results from gun clubs. In that regard, I extended a grace period (to the end of November) to get the results to me.

Only one club has results outstanding for numerous events and appears either uninterested or incapable of providing results. This undermines the integrity of the team points system and is unfair to those shooters who won events at a qualifying match who will not get credit for their points. After Nov. 30, however, I will name the teams without regard for missing results. I will leave it to shooters to address this with the defaulting club.

Next year I will not wait until November; since the target year ends on Aug. 31, a grace period to Sept. 30 should be more than adequate (and exceeds the time allotted for clubs to submit results to the ATA).

On another note, please remember, if you are participating in winter leagues where targets are thrown at ATA clubs and according to ATA rules/regulations, you can ask club management to register your league scores. This can be done at the end of the league season. A one-time nominal filing fee is charged (less than \$10). The league targets add to your lifetime target numbers but don't affect your averages. Most clubs will accommodate you.
