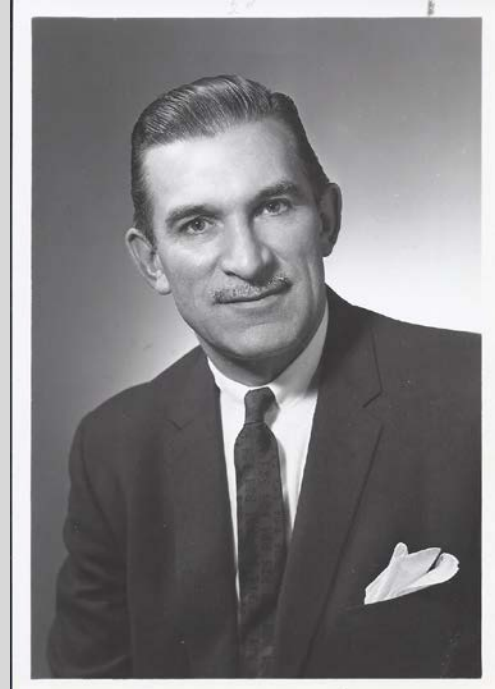


Thomas Oscar Oliver

Tom was born on February 18, 1911, and died on November 5, 1978. He was inducted into the OPTA Hall of Fame in June 1982.
