OPTA "CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS" COMPETITION

The OPTA is excited to present a new opportunity for shooters this year by running a year-long "Champion of Champions" competition. The OPTA, combined with the generous sponsorship of *Mott Liokossis Wealth Management Group*, will be awarding \$3200 in prizes to shooters. The goal of this initiative is to increase the number of registered targets thrown in Ontario and promote the competitive nature of trapshooting at our registered shoots. Hopefully, this initiative is also an incentive to OPTA members to shoot at different clubs across the province.

HOW TO QUALIFY:

15 shoot dates have been designated by OPTA clubs as a Champion of Champions Qualifying Shoots. All shoot dates are posted on the OPTA website (www.ontariotrap.com) and will be updated as needed. Only 100 (or 200) target events can be used as a qualifying event. Clubs can designate a maximum of 3 shooting days as qualifying shoots.

Qualifiers in each event will be awarded to:

Event Champion Junior Gold/Junior/Sub-Junior combined
Lady I/Lady II combined Sub-Veteran/Veteran/Senior Veteran combined
New Shooter (new ATA member in 2022-2023)

A shooter may qualify for a different category, including the Event Champion category, at different qualifying shoots. In all cases, it is the qualifying shooter's responsibility to inform the gun club which category they choose to be placed in. Ties for Champion and category at qualifying shoots will be determined by sub event, reverse score. If still tied, a draw will determine the winner. Only ONE person will qualify per category in any event at a shoot.

Provincial Champion of Champions Competition

Event and category winners will qualify to compete in the final Champion of Champions event, run concurrently with the Ontario Provincial Trapshooting Championships, being held from July 5-9, 2023, at the St Thomas Gun Club.

Scores posted by eligible shooters in the following events will be used to determine winners:

Singles: Event 6
Handicap: Event 3
Doubles: Event 5

All ties will carry over to the Championship events of the Provincials, and will be shot off if still unresolved.

Shooters who qualify as a Champion may not fall back to category if they have not qualified for said category. Shooters may only win one "Champion of Champions" prize per event, and are still eligible for all trophies, prizes, and added money being awarded at the Provincial Championships.
