

# WELCOME TO THE 2023 ONTARIO PROVINCIALTRAPSHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 2023 Ontario Provincial Trapshooting Championships will be held at the St Thomas Gun Club in St Thomas, Ontario Telephone: 519-633-2550. Website: www.stthomasgunclub.ca
- 2. CLASSIFICATION, SQUADDING & CASHIERING HOURS:

Tuesday, July 4: 1:00pm-4:00pm Wednesday-Sunday: 8:00am-4:00pm

- 3. SHOOTING WILL START AT 9:00AM SHARP EACH DAY
- 4. Daily fees ATA \$4.05, OPTA \$3.00
- 5. OPTA PARTICIPATION PINS will be available to the first 250 shooters.
- 6. STARTING BANKS for the events will be randomly rotated daily by the St Thomas Gun Club management and these will be posted around the grounds before each event.
- 7. Pat Traps and voice pulls will be used on all fields.
- 8. **ALL SINGLES AND HANDICAP EVENTS** will be shot 50 targets per trap, two traps per bank. **ALL DOUBLES EVENTS** will be shot 100 targets per trap, each trap being one bank. Events will be shot 5/post. The STGC reserves the right to change to 10/post if necessary.
- 9. PRACTICE ROUNDS will be \$7.00/25 targets.
- All Singles and Handicap shoot-offs will be on a 25-target basis, and Doubles will be on ten pair.
- 11. While the OPTA & St Thomas staff will make every effort to minimize announcements while shooting is taking place, announcement over the PA system can be made at any time.
- 12. You may use your own shells, including reloads.
- 13. There are no compulsory purses.
- 14. There will be a Hall of Fame Contributor Award in Sunday's Handicap Championship.
- 15. OPTA Directors or ATA Delegate will make all program interpretations.
- 16. Shooters winning or tying for high in class in any Singles or Doubles event will automatically be advanced at least one class for subsequent like events. All shooters (regardless of category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion will be advanced. Any shooter earning yardage in any Handicap event shall report to squadding to have their average card punched to their new yardage. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to have been notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin boards outside the clubhouse. Any shooter failing to follow item above will be subject to disqualification and will be ineligible for any trophy and/or money.

The Official ATA Rules will govern the 2023 Provincial Championships. This Committee reserves the right to refuse entry, disqualify or remove anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony and safety of this tournament, or violates ATA regulations and rules in any manner. There will be no refunds under these circumstances. This Committee may change, modify, delay, cancel or postpone any event at its discretion. Entry fees will only be refunded if an event is cancelled. The OPTA Committee reserves the right to move squads to any open bank in order to improve the efficiency of the shoot.

#### \* THE 2023 OPTA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING \*

This year's Annual General Meeting will be held on **Sunday, July 9, 2023** immediately following the OPTA Doubles Championship.

Any motion from the Floor during this meeting must be presented in writing at least 30 days in advance and in writing to the Board. **Every member is encouraged to attend!** 

#### PRE-SQUADDING

To sign up ahead of time, go to <a href="www.presquad.com">www.presquad.com</a>. You may pre-squad for yourself or your entire squad. Cost to pre-squad is \$1.35USD per post, and payable through the website. All Handicap squadding will be as per ATA rules - squads may have a 3-yard difference and 2-yard between shooters. **Pre-squadding available April 1-June 30, 2023.** For assistance with pre-squadding, contact <a href="mailto:secretarytreasurer.opta@gmail.com">secretarytreasurer.opta@gmail.com</a>.

## ANY SHOOTER WHO PRESQUADS FOR THE PROVINCIALS WILL ALSO BE PRE-CLASSIFIED BY THE SHOOT COMMITTEE.

You will simply have to cashier your entries at the club. It is the shooters responsibility to ensure their classification/special category declaration is correct before cashiering to shoot.

#### **CAMPING**

On behalf of the St Thomas Gun Club BOD, the following services will be provided:

- Plug in power. No air conditioners allowed. Amperage usage is critical.
- Shower facilities are available in the main clubhouse
- For insurance purposes, each camper using services may be required to sign a disclaimer.

#### TARGETS AND AMMUNITION

Fluorescent orange dome targets will be used in all events. St Thomas staff, along with the OPTA Board, will set targets daily in compliance with ATA guidelines. Targets can only be reset by Shoot Management and will only be done if there is a noticeable change in flight due to weather conditions or machine malfunction.

All ammunition used on the practice and program traps during this tournament must be ATA compliant. Reloads meeting this requirement are allowed. Due to the current shortage of ammunition shooters are encouraged to bring their own shells, although limited ammunition will be available and sold by the St Thomas Gun Club. All possible efforts to obtain and have shells available are being taken, however it is impossible to determine what stock of shells will be available for purchase. No other ammunition may be sold on the grounds without the authorization of the St. Thomas Gun Club. All empty hulls ejected onto the ground will become the property of the St. Thomas Gun Club.

#### **CLASSIFICATION**

Classification for members meeting the target requirements will be determined by the OPTA Classifying Committee in accordance with your official registered averages and/or known ability per the following tables. Decisions by this Committee will be final.

It is the SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY to ensure their Classification/Special Category is correct before cashiering for the shoot.

#### TARGET REQUIREMENTS

Shooters who do not have the following target requirements by the 1st day of the tournament (July  $5^{th}$ ) will be classified as follows:

**SINGLES:** Any shooter with fewer than 1000 16-yard targets combined **over the current** and **previous 2 years** will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher.

HANDICAP: Any Junior or Open shooter with fewer than 1000 handicap targets combined over the current and previous 2 years will be handicapped at 23 yards or their current handicap yardage, whichever is greater. Any Lady, Sub-Junior, Veteran or Senior Veteran with fewer than 1000 handicap targets over the current and previous 2 years will be handicapped at 20 yards or their current yardage, whichever is greater. Shooters with an established yardage who do not meet target requirements may shoot from their established yardage for "targets only" (not eligible for trophies or added money).

**DOUBLES:** Any shooter with fewer than 700 doubles targets combined **over the current** and **previous 2 years** will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher.

#### **CATEGORY DECLARATIONS:**

**Sub Junior**: a shooter who has not reached their 15th birthday.

Junior:
Junior Gold:

a shooter who is 15 but has not reached their 18th birthday.

a shooter who is 18 but has not reached their 23rd birthday.

Lady I:

a Female shooter who has not reached her 55th birthday.

a Female shooter who has reached her 55th birthday.

a shooter who is 55 but has not reached their 65th birthday.

Veteran:

a shooter who is 65 but has not reached their 70th birthday.

**Senior Vet**: a shooter who is 70 or older.

Any shooter who wishes to declare a special category must do so at the time of classification.

No shooter will be allowed to declare or change a category declaration after firing his/her first shot in the tournament. The only exception will be to correct a classification error made by the Classifying Committee – but a shooter failing to declare is not considered an error by the Classifying Committee. If a classification error is discovered BEFORE the close of an event, the error shall be corrected for that event and all subsequent events. If an error is discovered AFTER an event is closed, all corrections shall be made for subsequent events only. In either case, all previous events the shooter shot in will be in the "Open Category". This case may or may not affect the shooters eligibility for the HOA and HAA, depending on when the error was corrected. It is the shooter's responsibility to check the classification receipt to ensure accuracy.

#### **CATEGORY "FALL BACK"**

Any category shooter who is tied for Event Champion may shoot-off or carry-over for the championship trophy. If a category shooter fails to win the event, they will fall back to category but not to place, class or yardage. Any category shooter whose score qualifies for a potential trophy in his/her declared category must compete for category and not for place, class, or yardage group. Any category shooter whose score does not qualify for a potential trophy their category, may compete for place, class, or yardage trophies.

#### **JUNIOR AND SUB-JUNIOR SHOOTERS OPTA SPONSORSHIP**

Traditionally, the OPTA works to encourage youth to participate by sponsoring their targets in the Championship events. The OPTA will pay the target fees for any or all the 400 championship targets for all the **Resident and Non-Resident Youth** shooters who classify in the ATA's Junior or Sub-Junior category. Juniors and Sub-Juniors will pay the daily fees of \$4.05 ATA and \$3.00 OPTA. No options or purses (except the HOA Lewis) can be played when shooting discounted targets.

#### TROPHIES

Shooters can only win one trophy/Event, with the following exceptions:

- 1) NEW SHOOTER: A Resident Trophy for the OPTA member who joined the ATA in the 2022-23 shooting year. Generously sponsored by Ray Kassamanian.
- 2) TWO-SHOOTER TEAM: A Resident Trophy available in Event #7 to the winning team that registers PRIOR TO THE START OF EVENT 7. Two-shooter team must have a combined 16-yard average of 190% or lower (highest of current and previous target year). The cost is \$10/team to enter.
- 3) TROPHIES MAY BE PICKED UP DAILY: They will not be mailed!

#### ON THE FIELD PROCEDURES

Squads are expected to take the field as soon as the squad before them is finished. No shooter will be called to the line. Squads are allowed to wait three (3) minutes for absent members — or if a shooter experiences a gun breakdown/issue during the event. After 3 minutes, the squad must resume shooting. Targets must be shot on the day of the like event. There will be no advance shooting for any reason.

#### MAKE-UPS

No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets due to missed squads or gun repairs. You <u>must</u> report to Shoot Management to make up your targets no later than 15 minutes after the last shot is fired in that event. RE-SQUADDING is mandatory for those who have missed more than 50 targets with their assigned squad. There will be a \$20.00 re-squadding fee for any shooter who misses their squad.

#### **SHOOT-OFFS**

All ties in the Singles and Doubles events on Day 1-3 will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap events will be shot off at the end of the day of the event. Singles & Handicap shootoffs will be on a 25-target basis; Doubles will be based on 10 pair. There will be 3 calls for shootoffs. Shooters who do not respond within 3 minutes of the final call will forfeit.

#### **CASHIERING AND PAYOUTS**

All cashiering is managed by the St Thomas Gun Club. All entries are final once they are cashiered. There will be no refunds unless an event is cancelled. Cash, debit, or cheque will be accepted by the St Thomas Gun Club.

#### **ETIQUETTE**

Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from disruptive conduct while behind the firing line, especially during handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated. Shoot management reserves the right to disqualify or refuse entry to anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

#### **SOLICITING**

No soliciting or similar activities will be allowed on the grounds, nor shall any literature of any kind be distributed on the grounds without prior written approval by the OPTA and STGC.

#### **SHOOT RESULTS**

Shoot results will be posted throughout the day on the bulletin boards outside the clubhouse, as well as TV monitors. At the conclusion of the shoot, scores & trophy winners will be posted at <a href="https://www.ontariotrap.com">www.ontariotrap.com</a>. ATA Rules govern the posting of scores. Any protest concerning a score must be made before or immediately after the close of the competition to which such scores relate. A valid protest may only be made by a contestant who competed in the event.

#### TARGET SETTING

Shoot Management, along with the OPTA Target-Setting Committee will interpret predicted weather conditions and set targets each morning or upon event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules, using a crossbar.

#### **EXPLANATION OF PURSES & OPTIONS**

**1. OPTA HANDICAP PURSE:** This is a \$1.00 option run province-wide available to all shooters shooting registered Handicap targets. If a shooter breaks a minimum 50 straight, they are eligible for a Handicap Purse payout (ties divide). **Current Handicap Purse will be posted** 

at the STGC at the start of the shoot.

100 Straight collects 100% of the purse.

75 straight collects 50% of the purse. 50 straight collects 25% of the purse.

OPTA Handicap Jackpot (as of May 1): \$1006

- 2. 25's: Based on each of 4 25-target rounds. Pays 1 money (100%).
- **3.** 50s': Payable on three 50s first, middle, and last. Pays 2 places (60%/40%).
- **4. LEWIS OPTION:** Shooters are split into even, artificial "classes" from which payouts are determined. In a Lewis purse paying two places, the top two scores will share the money for the first class, ties divide. A second class is established at another pair of scores, and a similar payout made. This allows for payouts to the top guns in the event, while also allowing similar payouts to those who record lower scores.
- **5. JACKPOT PURSE:** Top scores divide the purse: Ties divide. Purse is split 40%-30%-20%-10%.
- **6. TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME PURSE:** ½ of the \$20 entry fee is a donation to the Trapshooting Hall of Fame. This donation provides support to the many projects undertaken by the Hall of Fame. The other half of the entry fee will be paid out in 2 Lewis classes, 60/40 high gun each class. The high participating shooter will receive a specially crafted Shamrock Leathers oak and leather wall clock. Ties will be resolved by reverse score, then a coin flip.
- 7. MOTT LIOKOSSIS HIGH-OVER-ALL LEWIS (\$3,300 ADDED

**MONEY):** \$20 to enter. Open to all shooters paying full price for 1000 targets (Event 1-9). Lewis pays 5 classes, 60%/40% each class. **MUST BE CASHIERED WITH EVENT 1.** See page 13 for more information.

**8. NEEDHAM FUNERAL HOMES HIGH-ALL-AROUND LEWIS (\$2,500 ADDED MONEY):** \$20 to enter. Open to all shooters paying full price for Events 7-9. Lewis pays 5 classes, 60%/40% each class. **MUST BE CASHIERED WITH EVENT 7.** See page 14 for more information.

#### THE MOTT LIOKOSSIS WEALTH MANAGEMENT GROUP HIGH-OVER-ALL LEWIS - \$3,300 ADDED MONEY

Blair Mott has generously donated \$5,500 to the OPTA in 2023. Of that, \$3,300 to be awarded as a High-Over-All Lewis on all 1000 program targets. The remainder of the money will be used to supplement our "Champion of Champions" program, as well as our trophy budget for the Provincials.


The High-Over-All Lewis Option (\$20) **MUST BE CASHIERED WITH EVENT 1 ENTRY.** All money collected will be added to the \$3,300 to create 5 classes. Money will be paid out in a maximum of 5 classes (60%/40% per class), with a minimum of 10 entries/class.

The Lewis format allows ALL shooters, regardless of ability, to have an equal chance of winning.

The OPTA is excited to offer \$10,500 in Added Money at the 2023 Provincials. Money will be awarded, with trophies, as outlined in the program. Also:

#### ADDED MONEY DAILY DRAW INFORMATION

Day 1 & 2 & 3 (\$250/day): A draw will be held at the end of each day. Entry into an event earns shooters an entry into the draw (1 event=1 entry, 2 events=2 entries). 10 winners will be selected daily. Winners receive \$25/each.






