How to Qualify

Clubs may designate UP TO THREE (3) SHOOTERS PER YEAR AS CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS QUALIFYING SHOOTERS.

Winners of the following categories (as per ATA guidelines) at a designated “Champion of Champions” shoot will qualify.

- Event Champion
- Junior Gold/Junior/Sub-Junior combined
- Lady I/Lady II combined
- Sub-Veteran/Veteran combined
- Senior Veteran
- New Shooter (new member in current target year)



Details

1. Event qualifiers will be held on 100 or 200 target events in all three disciplines.
2. Shooters must complete the entire 100 or 200 target event (as per shoot program) to qualify.
3. **The HOST CLUB** is responsible for submitting a winners list to the OPTA as part of their end of shoot reporting.
4. **THE HOST CLUB is responsible for accurately classifying ALL SHOOTERS** at shoots to determine winners.
5. A shooter may qualify for a different category, including event Champion, at different qualifying shoots.
6. **In all cases,** it is the shooter’s responsibility to declare category at any given shoot.
7. **If a category is not declared, shooter is placed in Open Category.**

Tie-breaker Procedures

1. Ties for Champion and category at qualifying shoots will be determined by reverse score by sub event.
2. If still tied, a draw will determine the winner.
3. Only ONE person will qualify per category in any event at a shoot.

Champion of Champions Competition

At the annual Ontario Provincial Championships, all qualifiers will have their scores recorded for the Singles, Handicap, and Doubles from the SECOND of such events of the shoot. **Shooters who qualify as a Champion may not fall back to category if they have not qualified for said category.** Shooters may only win one prize per event. All ties will carry over to the Championship events of the Provincial Shoot and will be shot off if still unresolved.

Singles (\$1,500)

\$500 – Champion	\$200 - JRG/JR/SJ combined
\$200 - Lady I/Lady II combined	\$200 - Sub Vet/Veteran combined
\$200 – Senior Veteran	\$200 - New Shooter Category

Handicap (\$1,500)

\$500 – Champion	\$200 - JRG/JR/SJ combined
\$200 - Lady I/Lady II combined	\$200 - Sub Vet/Veteran combined
\$200 – Senior Veteran	\$200 - New Shooter Category

Doubles (\$2,000)

\$700 – Champion	\$250 - JRG/JR/SJ combined
\$250 - Lady I/Lady II combined	\$250 - Sub Vet/Veteran combined
\$250 – Senior Veteran	\$300 - New Shooter Category
