2. CLASSIFICATION, SQUADDING & CASHIERING, PRACTICE TRAPS HOURS:  
Wednesday, July 1 12:00pm-4:00pm  
Thursday-Sunday: 8:00am-4:00pm
3. **SHOOTING WILL START AT 9:00AM SHARP EACH DAY**
4. Daily fees – ATA \$5.60, OPTA \$4.50
5. OPTA PARTICIPATION PINS will be available to the first 200 shooters.
6. STARTING BANKS for the events will be randomly rotated daily by management and these will be posted around the grounds before each event.
7. **ALL SINGLES AND HANDICAP EVENTS** will be shot on 4-trap banks (5/post, 25/trap).  
**ALL DOUBLES EVENTS** will be shot on 1-trap banks (100 targets per trap).
8. PRACTICE ROUNDS will be \$9.00/25 targets.
9. While the OPTA & HGC staff will make every effort to minimize announcements while shooting is taking place, announcement over the PA system can be made at any time.
10. You may use your own shells, including reloads.
11. There are no compulsory purses during registered target events.
12. OPTA Directors and/or ATA Delegates will make all program interpretations.
13. Shooters winning or tying for high in class in any Singles or Doubles event will automatically be advanced at least one class for subsequent like events. All shooters (regardless of category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion will be advanced. Any shooter earning yardage in any Handicap event shall report to squadding to be punched to their new yardage. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed shall be considered to have been notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin boards outside the clubhouse. **Any shooter failing to follow item above will be subject to disqualification and will be ineligible for any trophy and/or money.**

This Committee reserves the right to refuse entry, disqualify or remove anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony and safety of this tournament, or violates ATA regulations and rules in any manner. There will be no refunds under these circumstances. This Committee may change, modify, delay, cancel or postpone any event at its discretion. Entry fees will only be refunded if an event is cancelled. The OPTA Committee reserves the right to move squads to any open bank in order to improve the efficiency of the shoot.

### **\* THE 2026 OPTA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING \***

This year's Annual General Meeting will be held on **Sunday, July 5, 2026**, immediately following the OPTA Doubles Championship.

Any motion from the Floor during this meeting must be presented in writing at least 30 days in advance and in writing to the Board. **Every member is encouraged to attend!**

## **PRE-SQUADDING**

To sign up ahead of time, go to [www.presquad.com](http://www.presquad.com). You may pre-squad for yourself or your entire squad. Cost to pre-squad is \$1.40CAD per post, and payable through the website. All Handicap squadding will be as per ATA rules - squads may have a 2-yard difference and 2-yard between shooters. **Pre-squadding available April 1-June 28, 2026.** For assistance with pre-squadding, contact Beau Douglas at [secretarytreasurer.opta@gmail.com](mailto:secretarytreasurer.opta@gmail.com).

### **ANY SHOOTER WHO PRESQUADS FOR THE PROVINCIALS WILL ALSO BE PRE-CLASSIFIED BY THE SHOOT COMMITTEE.**

You will simply have to cashier your entries. It is the shooters responsibility to ensure their classification/special category declaration is correct before cashiering to shoot.

## **CAMPING**

The following services will be provided: **BOOK EARLY.**

- 15-amp power and water. Be mindful of your usage: No A/C units.
- For insurance purposes, each camper using services is required to sign a disclaimer.

## **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

The kitchen in the main clubhouse is open every day with a full menu from 7:30am-5:00pm. There will also be a BBQ on the west side of the gun club every day from 11am-3pm. If you would like food from the clubhouse but do not have time to go get it, the food can be delivered to you by calling 905-515-3521.

## **TARGETS AND AMMUNITION**

Target setting will be managed by the HGC, along with oversight from the OPTA, adhering to the standards outlined on pages 47-49, and Section XIII of the ATA Rulebook. Please note that target settings are determined by these guidelines and not individual shooter preferences. **Targets can only be reset by Shoot Committee & Management** and will only be done if there is a noticeable change in flight due to weather conditions or machine malfunction.

All ammunition used on the practice and program traps during this tournament must be ATA compliant. Reloads meeting this requirement are allowed. Shells can be checked at any time by a member of the Tournament Committee. Limited ammunition will be available and sold by the host club. All empty hulls ejected onto the ground will become the property of the Gun Club.

## **CLASSIFICATION**

**Classification for members meeting the target requirements will be determined by the OPTA Classifying Committee in accordance with your official registered averages and/or known ability (practice/league scores, disregarding abnormally low scores, etc.) per the following tables. Decisions by this Committee will be final.**

It is the **SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY** to present an up-to-date Average Card and to ensure their Classification/Special Category is correct before cashiering for the shoot.

## **TARGET REQUIREMENTS**

Targets shot prior to July 1 can be used to meet target minimums. Shooters who do not have the following target requirements before July 2<sup>nd</sup> will be classified as follows:

**SINGLES:** Any shooter with fewer than 1,000 16-yard targets **in the current and previous target year combined** will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher.

**HANDICAP:** Shooter with fewer than 1,000 handicap targets **in the current and previous target year combined** will be handicapped at **23 yards**, or their current handicap yardage (whichever is greater). **Senior Veterans are exempt from penalty yardage and will shoot their assigned yardage.** Shooters with an established yardage who do not meet target requirements may shoot from their established yardage for "targets only", meaning that they forfeit all rights to options, purses, trophies, awards or added money.

**DOUBLES:** Any shooter with fewer than 700 doubles targets **over the current and previous target year combined** will be placed in **CLASS B** or higher.

## **CATEGORY DECLARATIONS:**

| <b>Veteran:</b>     | a shooter who is 65 but has not reached their 70th birthday. |
| <b>Senior Vet:</b>  | a shooter who is 70 or older.                                |

**Any shooter who wishes to declare a special category must do so at the time of classification.**

**No shooter will be allowed to declare or change a category declaration after firing his/her first shot in the tournament. The only exception will be to correct a classification error made by the Classifying Committee (\*Shooter failing to declare is not considered an error by Committee). If a classification error is discovered BEFORE the close of an event, the error shall be corrected for that event and all subsequent events. If an error is discovered AFTER an event is closed, all corrections shall be made for subsequent events only. In either case, all previous events the shooter shot in will be in the "Open Category". This case may or may not affect the shooters eligibility for the HOA and HAA, depending on when the error was corrected. It is the shooter's responsibility to check the classification receipt to ensure accuracy.**

## **CATEGORY "FALL BACK"**

Any category shooter who is tied for Event Champion may shoot-off or carry-over for the championship trophy. If a category shooter fails to win the event, they will fall back to category - but not to place, class or yardage. Any category shooter whose score qualifies for a potential trophy in their declared category must compete for category and not for place, class, or yardage group. Any category shooter whose score does not qualify for a potential trophy their category may compete for place, class, or yardage trophies.

## **JUNIOR AND SUB-JUNIOR SHOOTERS OPTA SPONSORSHIP**

The Hamilton Gun Club has generously agreed to pay the target fees for all the **Resident and Non-Resident Youth** shooters who classify in the ATA's Junior or Sub-Junior category. Juniors and Sub-juniors will pay the daily fees of \$5.60 ATA and \$4.50 OPTA. **No options or purses can be played when shooting discounted targets.** Any Junior or Sub-Junior shooter who wishes to play **any** options or purses must pay full price for targets.

## **TROPHIES**

**Shooters can only win one trophy/Event, with the following exceptions:**

- 1) NEW SHOOTER:** A Resident Trophy for the OPTA member who joined the ATA in the 2025-26 shooting year. **Generously sponsored by Ray Kassamanian.**
- 2) TWO-SHOOTER TEAM:** A Resident Trophy available in Event #7 to the winning team that registers PRIOR TO THE START OF EVENT 7. Teams must have a combined 16-yard average of 190.00% or lower (highest of current and previous target year). The cost is \$20/team to enter. A shooter may only enter once. Money is split 75%/25% to top 2 teams.
- 3) TROPHIES MAY BE PICKED UP DAILY:** Hours will be posted at the entry building. Trophies will not be mailed.
- 4) UNCLAIMED TROPHIES** will be available until the 2027 Provincials, at which time they will be donated or recycled.

## **ON THE FIELD PROCEDURES**

Squads are expected to take the field as soon as the squad before them is finished. Shooters will NOT be called to the line. **Squads are to wait three (3) minutes for absent members – or if a shooter experiences a gun breakdown/issue during the event.** After 3 minutes, the squad must resume shooting. Targets must be shot on the day of the like event. There will be no advance shooting for any reason.

## **MAKE-UPS**

No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets due to missed squads or gun repairs. You must report to Shoot Management to make up your targets no later than 15 minutes after the last shot is fired in that event. RE-SQUADDING is mandatory for those who have missed more than 50 targets with their assigned squad. **There will be a \$20.00 re-squadding fee for any shooter who misses their squad.**

## **SHOOT-OFFS & CARRY-OVER**

All ties in the Singles and Doubles events on Day 1-2 will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap events will be shot off at the end of the day of the event.

There will be three “3-minute calls” for shoot-offs. Shooters who do not respond within 3 minutes of final call will forfeit.

## **CASHIERING AND PAYOUTS**

All cashiering is managed by the Hamilton Gun Club. Entries are final once they are paid. There will be no refunds unless an event is cancelled. Shooters may add options (before shooting) to events paid for but may not remove any once they are paid. **Please pay cash or cheque.** USD accepted at a reasonable exchange rate. No third-party cheques accepted.

## **ETIQUETTE**

Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from talking loudly or disruptive conduct while behind the firing line, especially during handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated. Shoot management reserves the right to disqualify or refuse entry to anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

## **SOLICITING**

No soliciting or similar activities will be allowed on the grounds, nor shall any literature of any kind be distributed on the grounds without prior written approval by the HGC & OPTA.

## **SHOOT RESULTS**

Shoot results will be posted throughout the day on the bulletin boards outside the entry building, as well as TV monitors. Results will also be posted on [www.shootscoreboard.com](http://www.shootscoreboard.com). At the conclusion of the shoot, scores & trophy winners will be posted at [www.ontariotrap.com](http://www.ontariotrap.com). ATA Rules govern the posting of scores. Any protest concerning a score must be made before or immediately after the close of the competition to which such scores relate. A valid protest may only be made by a contestant who competed in the event.

## **TARGET SETTING**

Shoot Management, along with oversight from the OPTA, will interpret predicted weather conditions and set targets each morning or upon event changes. **Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules, using a crossbar. NO SHOOTERS ARE PERMITTED TO MOVE OR RESET TARGETS.**

## **EXPLANATION OF PURSES & OPTIONS**

**1. OPTA HANDICAP PURSE:** This is a \$1.00 option run province-wide available to all shooters shooting registered Handicap targets. If a shooter breaks a minimum 50 straight, they are eligible for a Handicap Purse payout (ties divide).

**Handicap Purse: \$2,061++ as of April 20, 2026.**

100 Straight collects 100%. 75 straight collects 50%, or 50 straight collects 25% of the purse.

**2. 25's:** Based on each of 4 25-target rounds. Pays 1 money (100%).

**3. 50s':** Payable on three 50s – first, middle, & last. Pays 1 (100%) or 2 places (70%/30%). In Singles & Doubles, there are only two 50s per 100 – first and second. Ties divide.

**4. LEWIS OPTION:** Shooters are split into even, artificial “classes” from which payouts are determined. In a Lewis purse paying two places, the top two scores will share the money for the first class, ties divide.

**5. MODIFIED LEWIS OPTION:** Same as above except 1<sup>st</sup> class is split 60%/40%, and next number of classes (usually 3 or 4) pay 1 score, 100%.

**6. WINNER-TAKE-ALL OPTION:** \*Event 9 Only\*. Pays High Gun 100%. Ties Divide.

**7. PROGRESSIVE MIDDLE 50 JACKPOT:** (Events #2, #5, #9) Pays one money for Middle 50 straight, ties divide. If no 50 is broke, purse carries over, until Event #9, where the total accumulated purse will be paid to the high score(s) by option participants.

**8. GREAT EASTERN PURSE:** Top six scores pay (Ties divide). High score 25%, 2<sup>nd</sup> high score 15%, 3<sup>rd</sup> high score 10%, 4<sup>th</sup> high score 25%, 5<sup>th</sup> high score 15%, 6<sup>th</sup> high score 10%.

### **9. OPTA HIGH-OVER-ALL LEWIS (\$6,500 ADDED):**

**\$20 to enter.** Open to all shooters who shoot all 1,000 targets. Pays 6 classes, 60%/40% each class. **MUST BE CASHIERED WITH EVENT 1.** See page 13 for more information.

### **11. OPTA HIGH-ALL-AROUND LEWIS (\$2,500 ADDED MONEY):**

**\$20 to enter.** Open to all shooters paying full price for Events 7-9. Lewis pays 6 classes, 60%/40% each class. **MUST BE CASHIERED WITH EVENT 7.** See page 13 for more information.

### **12. MULTI-EVENT LEWIS (\$3,000 ADDED MONEY): \$20 per discipline to enter.**

Open to all shooters paying full price for Events 1-9. Lewis pays 5 classes, 60%/40% each class. See page 13 for more information.

### **OPTA HIGH-OVER-ALL LEWIS - \$6,500 ADDED MONEY**

\$6,500 will be added to the High-Over-All Lewis on all 1,000 program targets (Event 1-9). The High-Over-All Lewis Option (\$20) **MUST BE CASHIERED WITH EVENT 1 ENTRY**. All money collected will be added to the \$6,500 and paid out 6 classes (60%/40%/class). The Lewis format allows ALL shooters to have an equal chance of winning. Shooters must shoot all 1,000 targets (Events 1-9) to be eligible.

### **OPTA HIGH-ALL-AROUND LEWIS - \$2,500 ADDED MONEY**

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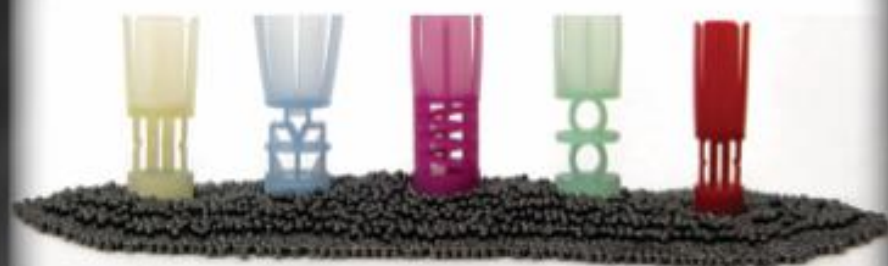
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## **ONTARIO TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME**
