Greetings from Ontario, Canada

At the time this article was written (January 17, 2013) our American firearm-owning colleagues face an attack on their Second Amendment rights. President Obama will likely do by executive order what he can get away with but the real fight is expected to be in the Senate.

We in Canada know what it is like to have oppressive gun "control" rammed through. The NRA is a critical ally. As I have often said, the devil is often in the details and all firearm owners must be vigilant in defending our rights (at least our American friends have the right to own and bear arms).

I am pleased to announce the 2013 Ontario Men's Delegate Team and the 2013 Ontario Delegate Category Team. Both teams are based on registered events won by resident trapshooters during the target year ending August 31, 2012. A threshold participation level is necessary before a pin is awarded and no shooter may win more than two pins in an event at the same club in the target year. The objective here is to make small ATA shoots a little more competitive and fun and to reward excellence. One's average is of no importance, so if a shooter does not shoot one particular discipline (like doubles) a pin in other disciplines can still be won and if enough pins are won, they are named to the Delegate (or Category Delegate) Team.

Congratulations to all Ontario shooters who won delegate pins. I awarded 108 men's delegate pins and 114 category delegate pins. And, a special congratulations to our shooters that distinguished themselves by earning a birth on one of the Delegate Teams. Here are the results:
